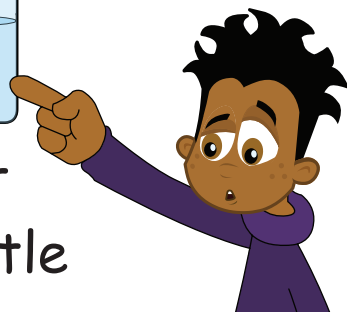
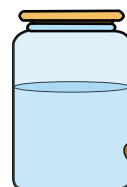

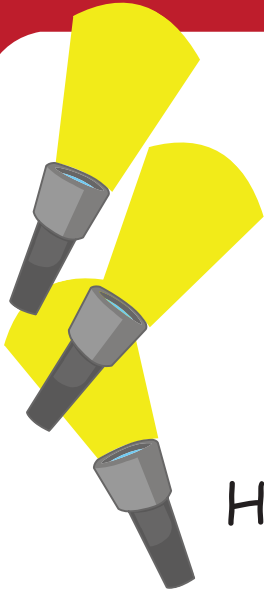
Chain
